



**Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)**  
**between**  
**Sindhi Language Authority (SLA), Hyderabad**  
**and**  
**Abdul Majid Bhurgri Institute of Language Engineering (AMBILE), Hyderabad**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of January, 2026, between: **Sindhi Language Authority (SLA)** and **Abdul Majid Bhurgri Institute of Language Engineering (AMBILE)**, Hyderabad, both functioning under the administrative control of the **Culture, Tourism, Antiquities & Archives Department**, Government of Sindh.

**Purpose**

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a formal collaboration between SLA and AMBILE for joint efforts toward the development and advancement of the Sindhi language, particularly in the area of the **Sindhi WordNet System** and other digital linguistic projects.

**Article 1: Deployment of SLA Employees at AMBILE**

1. **Five employees from SLA shall be assigned to work under the technical guidance and supervision of AMBILE.**
2. **These employees will contribute to the Speech Technology, Sindhi WordNet System, assisting in data sorting, annotation, and word tokenization.**
3. **AMBILE shall be responsible for training the nominated personnel in all required processes and tools.**
4. **The employees will continue to draw their salaries from SLA as per existing terms and conditions.**
5. **No additional allowance or remuneration shall be paid by SLA or AMBILE for the work under this collaboration.**
6. **SLA will nominate the five employees in writing, through the office of the Chairman, Sindhi Language Authority.**

**Article 2: Acknowledgment and Recognition**

1. **AMBILE shall acknowledge SLA's partnership and contributions in all relevant documentation, reports, and public dissemination relating to the Sindhi WordNet System.**
2. **The names of the nominated SLA employees will be credited individually for their contributions in the project.**
3. **Both AMBILE and SLA agree to recognize and highlight each other's role and services as official project partners on their respective websites and digital platforms.**

### Article 3: Utilization In Other Projects

1. Based on the needs of other ongoing or future **Sindhi language development projects**, AMBILE may also utilize the services of the deployed SLA professionals.
2. AMBILE shall ensure that **adequate training** is provided to the concerned professionals before assigning them to any additional projects.

### Article 4: Broader Institutional Collaboration

1. **AMBILE and SLA agree to collaborate** comprehensively for the advancement of the Sindhi language in the following aspects:
  - o SLA will provide **grammatical, lexical, and linguistic expertise** and support to AMBILE wherever required.
  - o AMBILE will offer **technical and digital support** to SLA in projects involving digitization and technology.
2. Both institutions shall act as **mutual knowledge and support partners** for all initiatives aligned with the preservation, promotion, and modernization of the Sindhi language.



### Article 5: Duration and Extension

1. This MoU shall be **initially valid for a period of three (03) years** from the date of signing.

2. Any modification to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both parties.
